Research into reading for pleasure places considerable emphasis on children being able to choose their own reading material. Sometimes this may not be what we would choose for them but as long as it is appropriate for their age then choosing their own book or other reading material is a way of encouraging children in their reading; it also provides a topic of conversation for you to explore with your child(children). Reading comics (the Beano, The Pheonix), Manga and comic books, books on their favourite sport or sporting personality or about films and music might be preferred. Anything which engages the child and which encourages them to read, if age appropriate, is acceptable for reading.

If a child has not yet found their 'forever book' or 'forever genre' then the staff in the LRC will be only too pleased to help them by guiding them through the different authors and genres available.
